Pine View, Three Legged Cross



Early 1900's

Pine View is situated on the corner of Lower Common and Ringwood Roads and was the home of Eli Sherred and his wife Lucy Mary Dibben who married in 1905. Their married daughter Mrs Hayter and her husband continued to live at the cottage.

Eli was a cousin of Mary Jane Joy neé Gritt - daughter of William Gritt, chimney sweep who married Mary Sherred.

Mary Jane Gritt married James Joy, a Market Gardener - who was a first and second cousin to Bessie Orman

through their shared Orman family dynasty which neatly brings us back to the previous Past and Present featuring the Orman's original ancestral home at Birch Tree Farm.

Today the beautifully maintained original old cottage still stands and hasn't changed to a great extent from the original view. The porch roof has been slightly altered and despite the chimney being removed from the main roof the slates still

have a little bit of tell tale discolouration where it was once located.
