**T**aken in the early twentieth century when the horse and cart was still the normal form of transport but modern family housing had started to be built along some of Verwood's Roads. The houses are well spread out with ample room for a large garden.

Many of these gardens have been divided to make room for additional dwellings, leaving just a small curtilage around the original house. These houses stand just

south of Glenwood Road and are now numbered 68 and 72 Manor Road. The oak tree under which the girl is sitting still remains.

Today, after the passage of around 100 years, the location hasn't really changed a great deal although the idyllic rural atmosphere has gone somewhat! Despite being considerably extended and partly hidden by foliage the properties are still identifiable and the road is now much busier but still follows the same curve.
